OHIO 811 PROJECT RENTAL ASSISTANCE

The Ohio 811 rental assistance program is a housing option for people with developmental disabilities to live independently and affordably while still receiving the supports that they need. Affordable, one-bedroom apartments are available to people with developmental disabilities in 36 counties across the state. A limited supply of two-bedroom apartments are available.

How it Works:

- 1. State agencies work with housing developments to designate apartments for the Ohio 811 Project Rental Assistance Program.
- 2. Participating County Boards of Developmental Disabilities match qualifying applicants with available apartments.

Program Eligibility:

- Ages 18-61
- · Qualifying disability, as defined by HUD
- Extremely low income (at or below 30% of area median income)
- Eligible for Medicaid
