Telehealth consults use video and audio and are accessible on any smartphone, computer, or tablet.

- Temper tantrums or behavioral problems
- Increased anxiety
- Sleep difficulties
- Toileting concerns
- Mealtime behaviors
- Noncompliance at home
- Improving coping skills

To schedule, call 513-636-8107 to speak to the Scheduling Team. Consult requests will be scheduled within 48 business hours. Insurance pre-authorization will not be available prior to your appointment. Please consult your insurance company if you have questions regarding psychology billing coverage.
